IRC Proposal Submission Steps

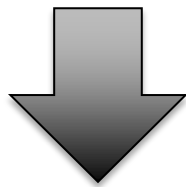
The BNC - IRC informs all researchers that the **Integrated Research Ethics Review Platform (IRERP)** is now the official system for the submission of **new research proposals** requiring ethical review.

All new proposals must be submitted through IRERP. New submissions will no longer be accepted through the old paper system format.

Steps For IRC proposal submission for faculties, students and researchers from B&C Medical College Teaching Hospital and Research Center and Purbanchal Cancer Hospital.

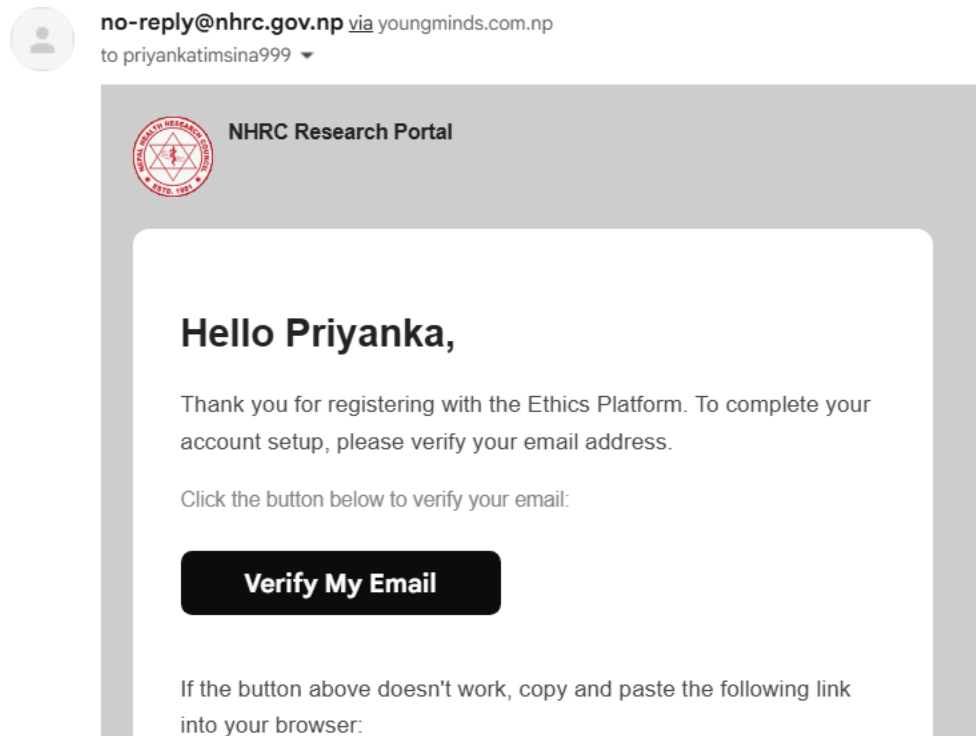

Fill up all your personal details, professional details and education and expertise. Your profile will be created

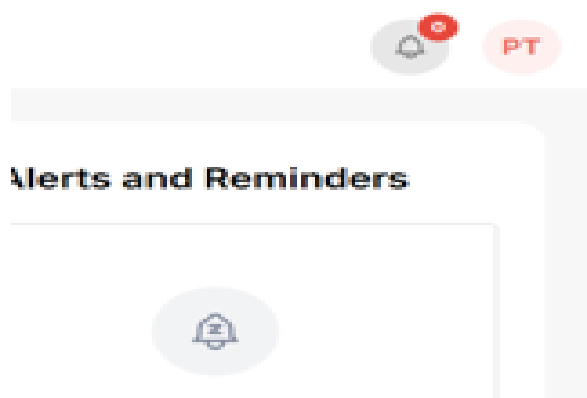
For Ethics Training Certificate:

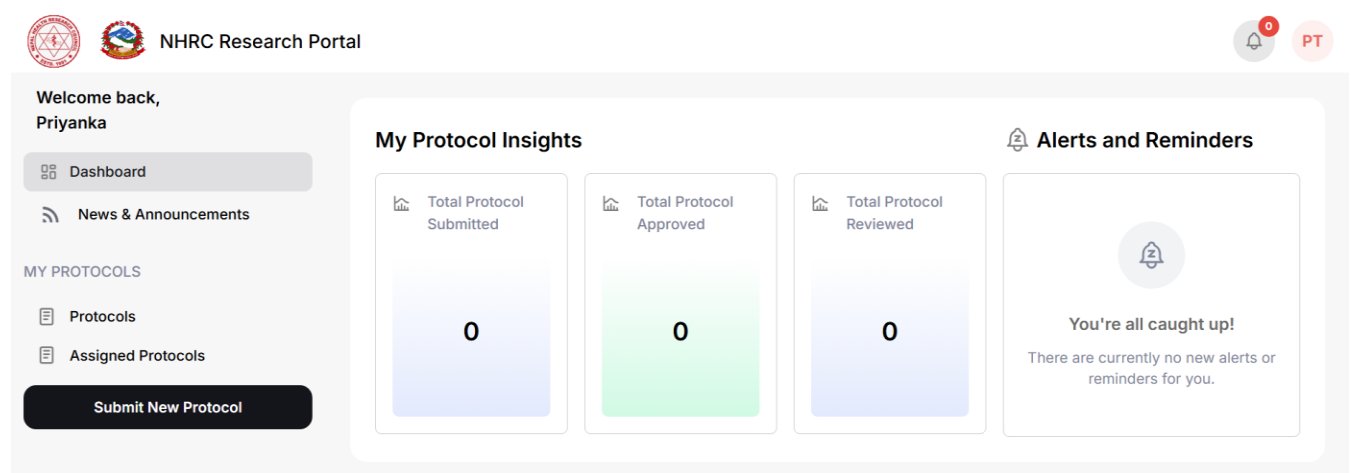
Creating and Downloading CV:
